Testing in Mercer County



- The Quakerbridge drive-up testing site moved to Trenton, in the parking lot across from the Mercer County Board of Social Services Building at 640 S Broad St. The entrance is off of Hudson at Cass. This is still a drive-up site through Friday, June 12th.
- Walk-up testing is still happening once per week in each Trenton ward.
- Testing is ongoing in Hightstown through the County.
- There is testing outside of the County process in Robbinsville and at pharmacies.
