Testing in Mercer County

- Mercer County OEM has ended their process after conducting more than 6,000 tests. Staffing was dependent on employees that were "on loan" from their normal positions, and those staff had to return to their original job functions.
- The City has put out an RFP for a testing contractor, but no decisions have been made yet. It is unclear what such a contract would cost the City and whether there are resources to pay for it.
- HJAHC is in the process of setting up testing for their patients. They also have some federal funding to cover the cost of testing those without insurance, but everyone they test will need to go through the normal HJA patient intake.
- Some pharmacies are offering testing, but the requirements and costs vary. An [updated list of testing resources](#) will be available next week.
