CompassionateNJ

- A campaign working towards rent suspension for all NJ tenants, mortgage and loan forbearance, and no impact on credit reporting during the COVID-19 crisis.
- [#ThePeoplesBill](#) passed and is now advancing to the Senate. [Bill S2340](#) provides protections from foreclosure and eviction for COVID impacted homeowners and tenants.
