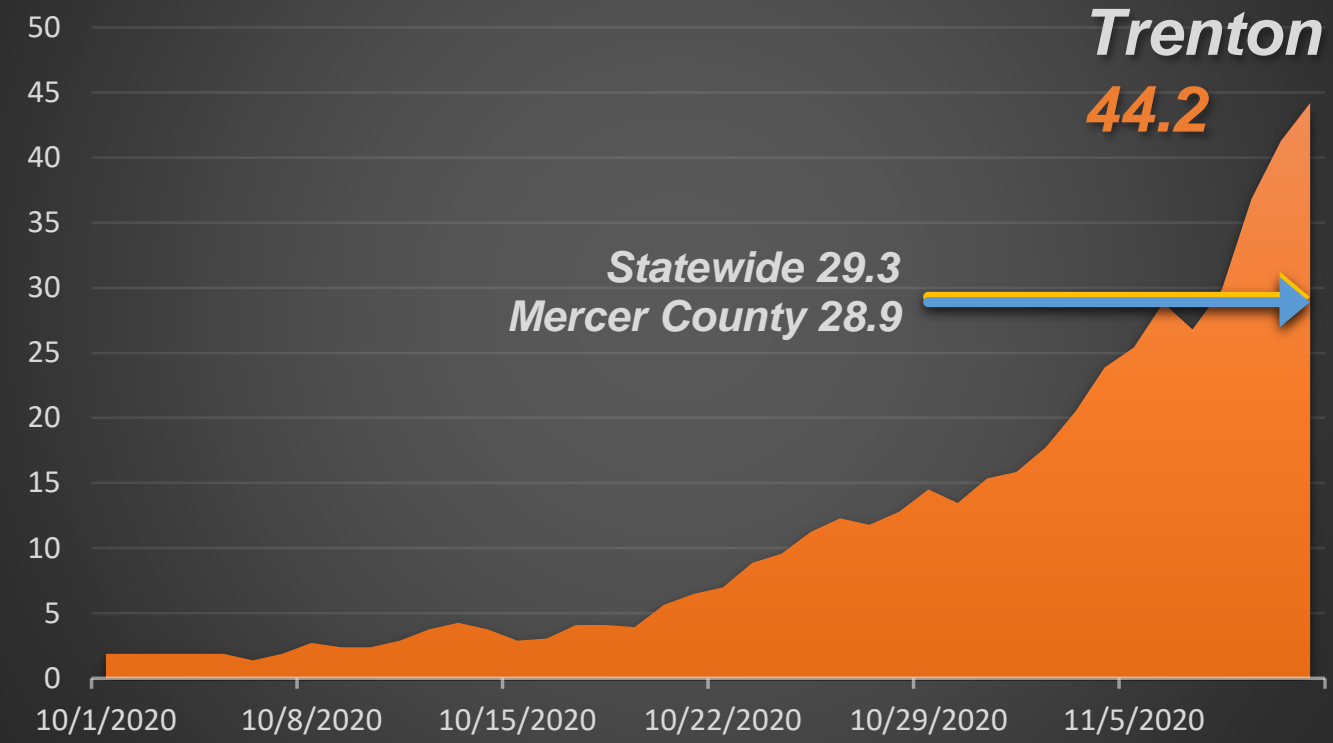

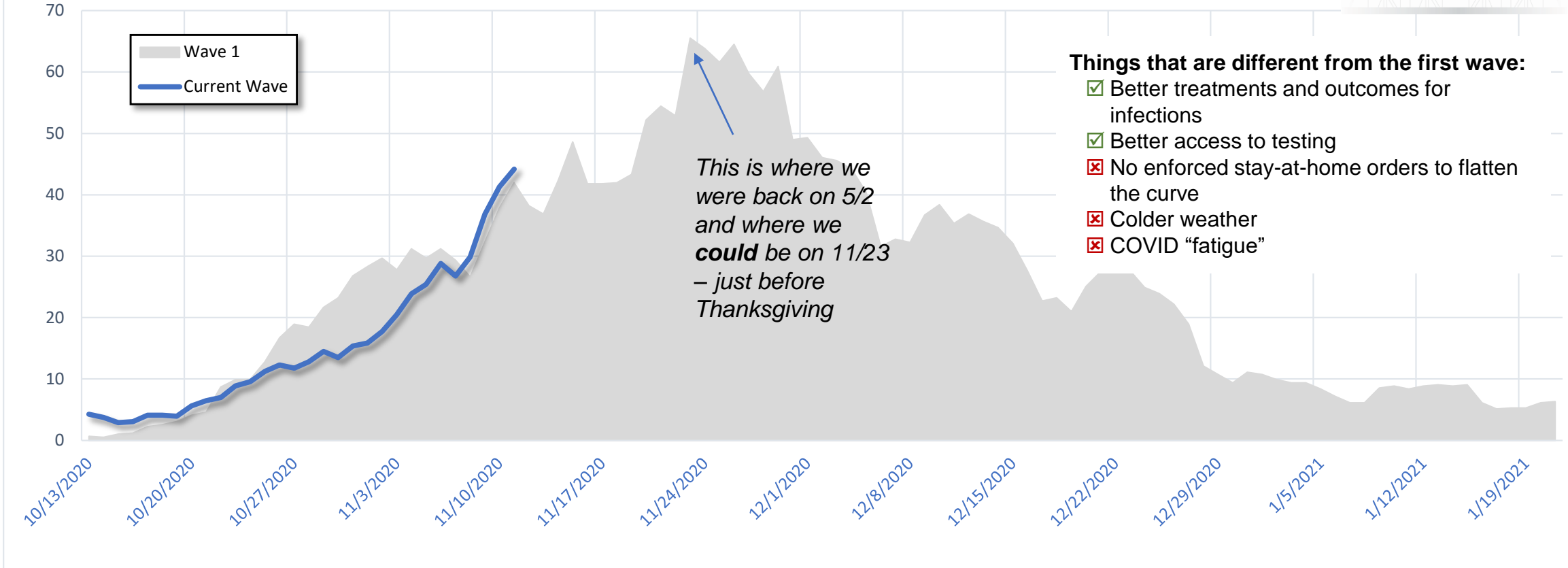

10/27/2020	11.8	2.1x
10/20/2020	5.6

Trenton 7-day Average of Confirmed COVID-19 Infections per 100,000



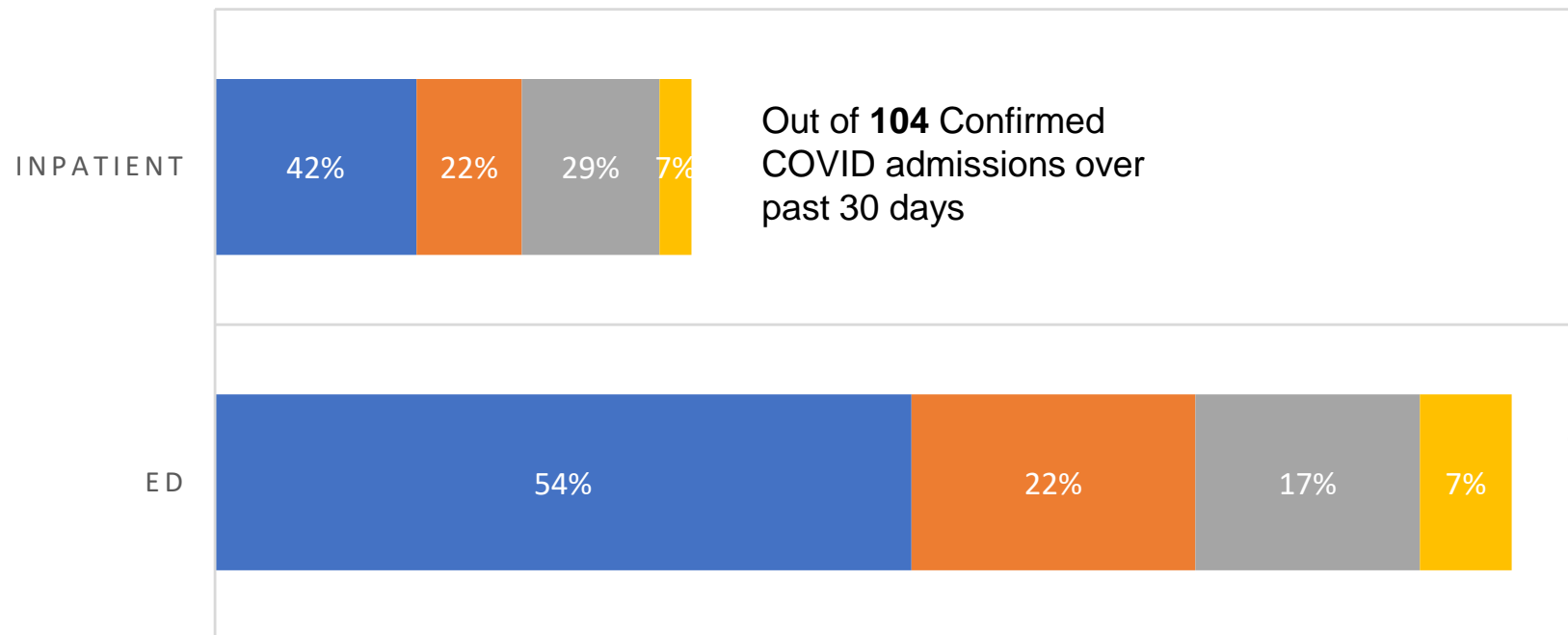
